- * All requests for ballots to be mailed must be received no later than Saturday, October 29, 2022. PLEASE CALL THE ELECTIONS OFFICE AT (386) 294-1261 TO MAKE YOUR REQUEST.
- * If you choose to vote by mail, please make sure your signature on file in the elections office is up-to-date.
- * Voted mail ballots must be returned to the elections office by 7:00 P.M. Election Day. (F.S.101.67(2) and 101.6103(2).

Please call the Elections Office at (386) 294-1261 or go online to www.lafayettevotes.net to make your request.

Florida law requires a voter to present a photo ID and signature ID when they vote.

Acceptable documents:
Florida Drivers License Florida Issued Identification Card Neighborhood Association ID U.S. Passport
Student ID Retirement Center ID Military ID Debit/Credit Card
Public Assistance ID Veterans ID Card Concealed Weapons Permit Employee ID Card

You are also required to vote in the precinct where you legally reside. Your address, along with your precinct name and number are designated on your Voter Information Card. If you have moved or had an address change since you last voted, please contact the elections office at 386-294-1261.

If you have any questions concerning your precinct, please call the Supervisor of Elections office. It is my goal and intention to serve the people of Lafayette County and do the best job for you and to uphold the integrity of this office and elections.
